Ismailia is on the west bank of the Suez Canal, it is the capital of the Ismailia Governorate. The city has a good weather. It has a population of 1,402,132 as of 2021. It is halfway between Port Said to the north and Suez to the south. It was founded in 1863, during the Suez Canal building, by Khedive Ismail, so it is named after him. The head office of the Suez Canal is in Ismailia at the shore of Lake Timsah. It has a large number

of buildings. Ismailia has several public and private schools. Ismailia is the home of the Suez Canal University, built in 1976 with the help of the Chinese Government to serve the region **منطقة** of Suez Canal and Sinai. Ismailia owns a successful football club, Ismaily SC. The team has won the Egyptian League three times (1967, 1991, 2002), the Egyptian Cup twice (1997, 2000), and the African Champions League once (1969) as the first Egyptian Arab Club team won this league.
